 - i. Yet, many of these non-member alternative solutions are email based and not good from IT and information security point of view
 - ii. What will happen to blockchain / distributed ledger technology based solutions as we see now the shutdown of we.trade and development of komgo moving away from blockchain
 - iii. This can act as a good motivation for our community to continue working with the data exchange enabling semantic model work
 - c. Jari Hänninen told of the new @GlobalTrade bidding and information exchange tool TFX
 - d. Many TF instrument tool processing solutions make some corporations move into “wait and see” mode not to make decisions that lead to wrong path, if other solutions will fly better
